

# Show Rules

**Show Committee has the right to combine, divide, and/or cancel any Class**

**This Show is run in accordance with State 4-H Horse Show Rules**

1. Proper tack & attire shall be enforced in all classes. Boots are required for all classes and properly fitted ASTM/SEI Safety helmets with chin straps secured must be worn by all riders when mounted.
2. Numbers to be worn on rider's back or saddle pad and the same number will be used in all five shows. Each horse and rider combination must have a number.
3. There will be a 2 minute time limit for entering the ring after the class has been called. Exception: Tack change - announcer must be notified. After the gate is closed no rider shall be permitted into the ring.
4. Decision of the judge, and/or timer is final.
5. Horse and rider shall be one combination for all 5 shows of the series. Rider can not cross divisions.
6. **Current negative Coggins Test is required as well as proof of current rabies (vaccination).**  
*Please have your papers ready.*
7. Show Committee (reserves) the right to (dismiss) any disorderly horse, rider or spectator and ask them to leave the grounds. Abuse of any animal will not be tolerated.
8. All dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are not allowed near the arena or ready ring.
9. No alcoholic beverages permitted.
10. Leadline and Prep exhibitors will receive participation ribbons.
11. All entrants must pay class fees prior to showing. No refund on class fees; if show is cancelled due to rain, fees will be credited to next show.
12. **Points for each horse and rider combination shall accumulate towards year-end awards.**  
Awards to be given out at the banquet - date to be announced later on during the year.
13. In order to receive awards you must attend 3 of the 5 shows.
14. **The Camden County 4-H Equine Committee, Camden County 4-H Assn., (and) the Camden County Board of Chosen Freeholders will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, damage or injury done to any property, persons, or animals in conjunction with this event.**
15. No stallions permitted on grounds.
- \*16. Those entering Beginner Rider/Green Horse Division may also enter Halter, Showmanship. Barrels and poles must be ridden at a walk/trot. The rider will be disqualified if the horse/pony lopes more than 2 steps.
17. The Beginner Rider/Green Horse Division is open to horse and rider combinations showing in their first or second year of showing together.
18. Show management reserves the right to combine or any classes with insufficient entries.
19. There will be a 25.00 fee for returned checks. Please make checks payable to the Camden County 4-H Equine Committee.
