

Show Rules

A Horse of Course, show organizers and management have the right to combine, divide, and/or cancel any Class. This Show is run in accordance with State 4-H Horse Show Rules

1. Proper tack & attire shall be enforced in all classes. Boots are required for all classes and properly fitted ASTM/SEI Safety helmets with chin straps secured must be worn by all riders when mounted.

2. Numbers to be worn on rider's back or saddle. Each horse and rider combination must have a number.

3. There will be a 2 minute time limit for entering the ring after the class has been called.

Exception: Tack change - announcer must be notified. After the gate is closed no rider shall be permitted into the ring.

4. Decision of the judge, A Horse of Course, show organizers, management and/or timer is final.

5. Current negative Coggins Test is required. Please have your papers ready.

6. A Horse of Course and show organizers (reserves) the right to (dismiss) any disorderly horse, rider or spectator and ask them to leave the grounds. Abuse of any animal will not be tolerated.

7. All dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are not allowed near the arena or ready ring.

8. No alcoholic beverages permitted.

9. Leadline and Prep exhibitors will receive participation ribbons.

10. All entrants must pay class fees prior to showing. There will be no refunds.

11. Points for each horse and rider combination shall accumulate towards end of day awards. Awards to be given out at the end of the day, in the arena.

12. A Horse of Course 4-H Club, the Camden County 4-H Equine Committee, Camden County 4-H Assn., (and) the Camden County Board of Chosen Freeholders will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, damage or injury done to any property, persons, or animals in conjunction with this event.

13. No stallions permitted on grounds.

14. Those entering Beginner Rider/Green Horse Division may also enter Halter, Showmanship, Poles and Barrels.

15. There will be a 50.00 fee for returned checks. Please make checks payable to the "A Horse of Course".
